Prominent biologists Engel, Lazzara awarded grants

The American Lung Association has awarded research grants to two prominent Adams biologists, Joe Lazzara and Alan Engel. Joe and Alan were chosen from numerous Indiana high school students who submitted proposals for projects in October. There was a total of eight grant winners.

The grants were awarded on the basis of prior research and a proposal for a new project. Last year, Joe studied the effects of




exercising upon atherosclerosis in mice. His work was done using a treadmill to run the mice. Alan's project involved altered diets and aging. He increased the salt, fat, or sucrose content of the diets. This year, both Joe and Alan are continuing their work in the same areas. The funds from the grants, \$150, will be used to support the research done this year.

Joe Lazzara's research project involves exercise. Exercise, which is the current health fad in the United States, improves the physical fitness of the body. Because exercise effectively lowers body weight, it has been recommended as a deterrent to obesity and heart disease. In addition, running may lower the cholesterol levels. Joe hopes to find the difference between the weekend jogger and the armchair quarterback.

In his previous research, Joe exercised two groups of mice (one group once a week, the other daily). Through this, the difference between the daily

jogger and the weekend jogger can be seen. The purpose of Joe's research was to see if exercise prevented atherosclerosis. His data showed that running caused a decrease in body weight. This was caused by increased calorie usage by the body. Also, the food consumption of the mice that ran was significantly lowered. Most importantly, cholesterol levels were lowered by daily exercise. Because of this, Joe was able to conclude that exercise can prevent atherosclerosis which leads to heart disease.

Joe's research this year concerns exercise and stress. Some scientists believe that the weight loss accompanying exercise is caused by stress. To study this, Joe is administering vitamin C to his mice. Vitamin C



or ascorbic acid is believed to relieve stress. Through this study, Joe hopes to determine the exact benefits of exercise. This project, "Studies in the Possible Anti-Respiratory Stress Effects of Supplemental Ascorbic Acid on Treadmill Running," is being funded by the grant.


EXPERIMENTATION

Alan

Alan Engel's research involves the study of the effects altered diets are upon the body. Alan is interested in the physiological changes caused by increased salt, fat, or sucrose intake. These substances are vital to the body's nutrition. However, increased amounts in the diet may be harmful. Last year, Alan studied specifically how the aging process is affected by dietary alterations.

Aging is a natural body process which has puzzled man for many years. Scientists still do not fully understand the aging process. Various theories have been put forth though. One such theory states that the body deteriorates because of wear and tear. According to this idea, the body will wear out with use. The goal of researchers is to understand this process so methods of delaying aging can be found. This was the purpose of Alan's project. He hoped to see how altered diets speeded or slowed aging.

Alan administered diets with increased salt (4 times normal), fat (plus 10%), and sucrose (plus



10%) to mice and performed various tests. His results show significant changes caused by the altered diets. Salt retention was increased by the additional salt. This could cause hypertension which would lead to an early death. Food consumption was lower in the groups given

different diets. This indicates that the mice given the altered diets did not adjust to the diets. Overall, the data indicated that the diets would cause early aging.

Alan's current project, which is being funded by the grant, is titled "Possible Effects of Altered Diets on Allergic Reactions to Ragweed Pollen." He will determine if the diets weaken the body's defenses and thus cause premature aging. Alan would like to thank Mr. Longenecker for his guidance, Brad Sakaguchi and Joe Lazzara for their help, his mother for typing his report, and his father "for not helping" so he could do the project himself.

"Watching her play is like sitting through a volleyball training film" exclaimed one awed spectator. "She's fantastic." Well, she's not immortal, but Junior spiker Julie Yazel certainly has what it takes to gain state-wide praise and recognition. Combining 193 spike kills with 57 solo blocks and 85 assists, Yazel has consistently exhibited an awesome show of power at the net as well as in the back court. Her incredible .229% spiking average along with strong serving, digging and passing skills have earned Yazel a berth on the N.I.C. squad and recognition as the Tribune's athlete of the week. But last week both those awards were dwarfed when the Indiana Coaches of Girls' Sports Association (ICGSA) announced the formation of the first all-state girls' volleyball team. Out of 89 girls nominated statewide, Yazel was one of only 18 starters actually chosen for the team, making her the first all-stater in the history of Adams volleyball. "I was shocked!" smiled Yazel. "It's a great honor."

A highly talented girl, Yazel attributes her recent excellence to her coach, Sue Ganser and claims she has helped her immensely. "She's an extremely coachable kid," explains Miss Ganser. "She always gives 100%."

As a Junior, Yazel has one more year at Adams and next year she will undoubtedly prove to be an even stronger asset to one of the most reputable volleyball programs in the state of Indiana.



Six-foot-two, two hundred and fifteen pounds - definitely a force to be reckoned with, senior letterman Lamar Taylor has proven he can move his weight extremely well. Operating from his starting position at defensive noseguard, Taylor tallied 27 solo tackles and 14 assists for the Eagles this season, giving him the second highest number of tackling points on the team. Causing three fumbles and recovering one, Taylor continually made his presence known in the opposing team's backfield. By earning the respect of many area coaches throughout the season, Taylor has recently been named first string all-N.I.C. making him the highest ranked noseguard in the conference. "I think the other teams found Lamar in their backfield a lot, messing things up," says Head Coach Andy Mihail. "He has incredible speed and agility for a big man." Taylor proved equally impressive offensively. "Actually, I feel I played better on offense than on defense," he explains. Mihail moves on

On Nov. 25, 1981, Andrew Mihail, Head Coach of John Adams football team, resigned his post. This ended Coach Mihail's four year term as the helmsman of the Eagle's football program. These four years spanned periods of both frustration and satisfaction, of victory and disappointment.

Coach Mihail's resignation was both expected and unexpected. Although the general disappointment of another lagging season (2-8) was great, some didn't believe that Mihail would resign. Many, however, including Adam's principal, Mr. Przybysz, and Athletic Director, Ed Szucs, weren't as surprised at this action, sympathizing with Coach Mihail over presiding over yet another losing season.

Mr. Szucs explained, in an interview, that Mr. Mihail, when interviewed for the job four years ago, expressed an outline of goals he would like to achieve as head coach. When these goals weren't met, Mr. Szucs continued, then Coach Mihail decided to resign his post in order to usher in a new program, and to look for another course of action for himself. Mr. Przybysz concurred, largely, with Athletic Director Szucs.

Coach Mihail described his career at Adams as one of unmet goals. Success as a

football team, he explained, had not been reached during his nine year tenure, both as assistant coach for five years, and head coach for the past four years. He cited his team's dismal 8-32 record for the past four years as evidence of this.

Mr. Mihail will be missed as a football coach at Adams. When interviewed, assistant football coaches Rich Coffey, Bill Farrel, Mark Ingole, and Jim Kominkiewicz all agreed that as far as leadership, organization, and personality go, Mihail was undoubtedly the best. Mr. Przybysz and Mr. Szucs also praised Mihail as one who was an extremely hard-working, dedicated coach and teacher. Coach Kominkiewicz could find no fault with Mihail, while Coach Farrel found that the problems besetting Mihail as a coach were those of the team's 'make-up'; saying that the team's 'chemistry' didn't work toward the team's and Mihail's advantage.

While Mr. Mihail has expressed wishes to move on and to be an assistant football coach at another South Bend high school, he's made no immediate plans, but hopes to just 'look around' for another position.

A replacement for Mihail's position will hopefully be filled sometime in mid-January, possibly on Jan. 15, says Mr. Szucs.






